- Applicants must plan to attend an institution of higher learning that is an eleemosynary junior or senior college that is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools or a comparable regional accrediting organization.
- Applicants must demonstrate the ability to successfully perform in the academic program he/she chooses.

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review the applications and make the award selection based on the above criteria. All awards will be made without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, sex or disability.
