The Scholarship Selection Committee will review the applications and writing samples and make the award selection based on the above criteria. All awards will be made without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, sex or disability.

APPLICATION PROCESS

All applicants must complete the scholarship application form and submit it along with required attachments to the Guidance Department of Gilbert High School. The Social Development Committee of the Gilbert Ruritan Club will evaluate the scholarship applications and determine which student most fully meets the Ruritan Club's criteria.
