

WILLIAM S. AND ELIZABETH B. HEATH SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION INFORMATION

The William S. and Elizabeth B. Heath Endowment Fund will provide annual scholarships to those desiring to pursue a college education. The award will be announced in the spring with payment to an accredited college or university of the student's choice for fall enrollment.

APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Applicants must be a qualified employee of the former Carolina Coca-Cola Bottling Company, or a legal dependent of a qualified employee. A qualified employee is a person who was employed by the former Carolina Coca-Cola Bottling Company.
- Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA during their junior and senior years of high school. Qualified students who do not meet the minimum high school GPA requirement may be considered after they maintain a 2.5 GPA on a minimum of 12 hours of college level work.
- Applicants should demonstrate a high level of school and community involvement as shown by participation in extra-curricular activities.
- Applicants must attend an institution of higher learning that is an eleemosynary junior or senior college that is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools or a comparable regional accrediting organization.
- Applicants must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), obtainable from a guidance counselor, as well as the Financial Aid Release Form included with the scholarship application.
- If no applicants meet the above criteria, the Scholarship Selection Committee may award a scholarship to one or more outstanding senior(s) from the following high schools: Sumter High School, Crestwood High School, Lakewood High School, Thomas Sumter Academy, Wilson Hall School, Sumter Catholic High School, or any other such high school serving students in Sumter County.
- This scholarship cannot be used to substitute for grant aid that an institution has committed to a student.
- Scholarships are renewable if students maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA while attending an institution of higher learning.
