Administered through Central Carolina Community Foundation, the Daughters of the Holy Cross – Sara Hempley Scholarship will provide an academic scholarship in the amount of \$500 to a non-traditional student to obtain a degree from technical, two or four year college.

APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Priority will be given to applicants who are residents of Richland County School District 1 and who have some degree of life and work experience rather than persons recently out of high school.
- Applicants must hold a GED equivalent or high school diploma.
- Applicant must demonstrate the ability to successfully perform in the academic program he/she chooses.
- Applicant must demonstrate financial need.
- Recommendations will be considered from an employer, lay or staff leaders of faith community, and instructors not related to the applicant.
- Applicants receiving a scholarship must attend an institution of higher learning which is an eleemosynary, two/four year or technical junior or senior college that is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools or a comparable regional accrediting organization or a vocational school.
- This scholarship will not be used to substitute for grant aid that an institution has committed to a student.
- Scholarship award must be used for tuition, books, fees, or equipment needed for course work while attending the institution.
- Scholarship recipients may reapply if making satisfactory academic progress.

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review the applications and make the award selection based on the above criteria. All awards will be made without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, sex or disability.
