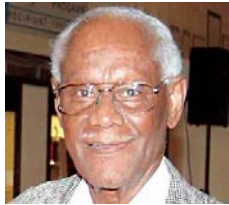


DR. ROBERT HOWARD/WHS SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Since 1933 Dr. Robert E. Howard has served students, parents and the Orangeburg community as a teacher, coach, principal and school district administrator. Most residents of Orangeburg remember him as the principal of Wilkinson High School, a premier secondary school in South Carolina. During his tenure as the longest serving principal at Wilkinson, the school achieved excellence in academics, sports and development of skilled craftsmen.

The Dr. Robert E. Howard/Wilkinson High School Scholarship Fund honors the legacy of the school's last principal and all faculty and staff by recognizing the difference they made in the lives of all WHS graduates during its 33 year history.

APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Applicant must be a graduating senior from Orangeburg-Wilkinson High School.
- Applicant must have achieved a cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant must demonstrate the ability to successfully perform in the academic program he/she chooses.
- Applicant must demonstrate financial need.
- Applicant should demonstrate a high level of school and community involvement as shown by participation in extra-curricular activities.
- Applicant must attend Claflin University or South Carolina State University.
- This scholarship will not be used to substitute for grant aid that an institution has committed to a student.

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review the applications and make the award selection based on the above criteria. All awards will be made without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, sex or disability.
