APPLICATION INFORMATION

Estelle Jones, born and raised in Hopkins, South Carolina, often talked of how she wished she had gone to nursing school or college. The friends and loved ones of Estelle Jones have set up a scholarship fund in memory of her. Administered through Central Carolina Community Foundation, the Estelle Jones Memorial Scholarship will provide an annual scholarship to a high school student who is a member of Zion Damascus Church Number Two desiring to pursue education after high school. The scholarship is for one year; however, scholarship recipients making satisfactory academic progress may reapply.

APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Applicants must graduate from a public or private high school serving Richland county or must hold a GED equivalent.
- Preference will be given to students who are members of Zion Damascus Church Number Two. If there are no qualified applicants of Zion Damascus Church Number Two, the scholarship may be awarded to another applicant who is from the Hopkins community and who satisfies all of the other criteria for eligibility.
- Applicants must demonstrate the ability to successfully perform in the academic program he/she chooses.
- Applicants must demonstrate financial need.
- Applicants should demonstrate a high level of school and community involvement as shown by participation in extra-curricular activities.
- Applicants receiving a scholarship must attend an institution of higher learning which is an eleemosynary junior or senior college that is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools or a comparable regional accrediting organization or a vocational school.
- This scholarship will not be used to substitute for grant aid that an institution has committed to a student.

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review the applications and make the award selection based on the above criteria. All awards will be made without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, sex or disability.
