### APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Applicants must be graduating seniors of Richland Northeast High School.
- Applicants must have a high school cumulative GPA of 3.0. on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must include a transcript and resume.
- Applicants must include at least one letter of recommendation from a student organization advisor or other adult who is well acquainted with the applicant.
- Applicant must submit an essay of no more than 1,200 words which directly addresses a selected question.
- Applicant receiving a scholarship must attend a four year institution of higher learning that is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools or a comparable regional accrediting organization or a vocational school.
- Selection will be based on leadership, service and scholarship.
- This scholarship will not be used to substitute for a grant aid that an institution has committed to a student.

The Terry A. McCoy Leadership Scholarship Selection Committee will review applications and make the award selection based on the above criteria. All awards will be made without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, sex or disability.

### APPLICATION PROCESS
