APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Applicants must be a senior at graduating senior at Andrew Jackson High School in Lancaster County.
- Applicants must demonstrate to the Scholarship Committee his/her ability to successfully perform in the academic program he/she chooses.
- Applicants are required to write an essay that shows clear indication of goals and the benefit that the scholarship will give to the student in accomplishing those goals.
- Applicants' rewards and accomplishments should be clear evidence of goal-setting, worthwhile activities in and out of school, and potential for success.
- Applicants receiving a scholarship must attend an institution of higher learning which is an eleemosynary junior or senior college that is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools or a comparable regional accrediting organization or a vocational school.

The William L. McDow Scholarship Selection Committee will review the applications and attachments and make the award selection based on the above criteria. All awards will be made without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, sex or disability.

APPLICATION PROCESS
