APPLICATION INFORMATION

The Pierce/Zimmerman Scholarship Fund was created to assist families of South Carolina State University's Facilities Management Division. The award will provide a \$1,000 scholarship to those desiring to pursue a college education at South Carolina State University.

APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Applicant must be a legal dependent of a qualified employee of the Facilities Management Division at South Carolina State University.
- A qualified employee is defined as a person employed within the Facilities Management Division at South Carolina State University for at least 90 days as of the date of the scholarship application.
- Applicant must have a high school cumulative GPA of 2.5. on a 4.0 scale. Qualified students who do not meet the minimum high school GPA requirement may be considered after they maintain a 2.0 GPA on a minimum of 12 hours of college level work.
- Scholarships may be renewable if students maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA while attending South Carolina State University.
- Applicants should demonstrate a high level of school and community involvement as demonstrated by participation in extracurricular activities.
- Applicants must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), obtainable from a guidance counselor, as well as the Financial Aid Information Release Form included with the scholarship application.
- This scholarship will not be used to substitute for a grant aid that an institution has committed to a student.

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review the applications and writing samples and make the award selection based on the above criteria. All awards will be made without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, sex or disability.
