APPLICATION CRITERIA

- The applicant must be a senior enrolled in a CIS of the Midlands' program.
- The applicant must show leadership potential.
- The applicant must be accepted into an institution of higher education.
- The applicant must submit an essay describing the leadership qualities he/she possess and tell how he/she has used those qualities. The essay should be no more than two pages, typed, double-spaced.
- The applicant must submit one teacher recommendation for the scholarship - no more than one page. Recommendation should address academic achievement, attitude, and/or community service.

The Rhittie Gettone "Leading By Example" Scholarship Selection Committee will review applicants and make the award selection based on the above criteria. All awards will be made without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, sex or disability.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application and all required attachments should be submitted to Communities In Schools of the Midlands, Inc. The Selection Committee will select the top-five applicants for interviews.
