APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Applicant must be a current student in upper division or have admission to the upper division of the College of Nursing at the University of South Carolina and have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Applicant must be full-time student during the fall and spring semesters (12 semester hours for undergraduate student).
- An eligible recipient must uphold commitment to the University of South Carolina and the local community through active participation in campus life and volunteer service.
- Academic achievement, school/community activities, financial need, and the applicant's personal statement will be considered when making the selections.
- The Bobbi Rossi Memorial Scholarship is an annual scholarship. The scholarship is renewable with satisfactory academic performance, completion of 12 hours of course work for each of the two semesters preceding the academic year for which the renewal scholarship is being sought, and review of the recipients' character and motivation.
- Checks will be made payable to the recipient and the University of South Carolina and distributed through the financial aid office. The check will be mailed to the University prior to registration. In the event a student withdraws from or does not attend the College of Nursing, the student will be responsible for informing the College of Nursing and the Foundation of this change.

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review the applications and writing samples and make the award selection based on the above criteria. All awards will be made without regard to race, gender, national origin, age, sexual orientation or disability.
