This scholarship was established in memory of H. Eugene Webb, Jr., by his sister Mary Christine Webb. Mr. Webb was a longtime member of the Columbia High School faculty in Richland School District 1, and Miss Webb served as a faculty member at Columbia High School before becoming the principal at Dreher High School. Miss Webb was United Methodist and had a home at Lake Junaluska. She was interested in the United Methodist Church doing more in evangelism.

APPLICATION CRITERIA

Applicant must:

- be a United Methodist clergy candidate from South Carolina, with an intention to return to South Carolina to serve in a pastoral ministry setting.
- have achieved a cumulative GPA of at least 2.8 on a 4.0 scale as demonstrated by an official university or college transcript for the years immediately prior to this application.
- demonstrate financial need.
- enroll in the Asbury Seminary program with emphasis on evangelism in pastoral ministry.
- demonstrate faithful involvement in a local worship community, as well as the seminary community.
- include two letters of recommendation, which may be from clergy, teachers, employers or other non-family individuals with knowledge of the applicant's qualifications.

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review the applications and compositions and make the award selection based on the above criteria. All awards will be made without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, sex or disability.

APPLICATION PROCESS

All applicants must complete the scholarship application form and submit it along with required attachments to the Department of Financial Aid by March 1.
